RE: AMENDING THE PREDICTABLE FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE COUNTY RECORDER'S OFFICE TO RECODIFY FEES

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Illinois, on August 22, 2017, signed into law Public Act 100-0271, which requires counties to adopt a predictable fee schedule for the County Recorder's Office; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Act 103-0884 if a county has previously adopted a resolution adopting a predictable fee schedule, the county must adopt a resolution revising that predictable fee schedule to be consistent with 55 ILCS 5/3-5018.2; and

WHEREAS, a notice of this resolution must be posted in the Coles County Recorder's Office for at least two weeks prior, but not more than four weeks prior to the date of adoption below; and

WHEREAS, the changes to the fees shall take into effect on January 1, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, the predictable fee schedule is attached as Exhibit A and was prepared by the County Recorder pursuant to the new law; and,

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee at its regular scheduled meeting of November 4, 2024, discussed, reviewed and considered the County Recorder's proposed predictable fee schedule and recommends the proposed fees take effect January 1, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the County Board of Charleston, Illinois that after review, discussion and consideration at his regularly scheduled board meeting on November 12, 2024, hereby adopts the predictable fee schedule prepared by the County Recorder and the changes to the fee schedule shall take effect January 1, 2025.

WHEREAS, the County Board of Coles County has entered into an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation for transfer of Federal Surface Transportation Program funds to pay one-half of the salary paid to the County Engineer.
