Subject: **Coles County Health Department COVID-19 Case Count Updates**

Coles County Health Department, (CCHD) is reporting additional laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases. Our total confirmed COVID-19 laboratory case count for Coles County as of April 22, 2021, is **Five-Thousand, Seven-Hundred and One** with **Seven** currently hospitalized, **Five-Thousand, Five-Hundred and Six** recovered **Ninety-Four** deceased, and **Ninety-Four** recovering.

Case Data for April 22, 2021: **12** new cases

COVID-19 positive cases are increasing in Coles County. We are seeing community spread. Anyone who is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should stay home, isolate, consult with your provider, and test. Symptoms can include a wide range of the following: congestion, runny nose, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, headache, muscle or body aches, fatigue, fever, chills, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, or loss of taste or smell. Symptoms may appear 2 to 14 days after exposure to the COVID-19 virus.
