Coles County Health Department, (CCHD) is reporting additional laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases. Our total confirmed COVID-19 laboratory case count for Coles County as of April 7, 2021, is **Five –Thousand, Five-Hundred and Ninety-Four** with **Four** currently hospitalized, **Five-Thousand, Four-Hundred and Fifty-Six** recovered **Ninety-Four** deceased, and **Forty** recovering.
