Coles County Health Department, (CCHD) is reporting additional laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases. Our total confirmed COVID-19 laboratory case count for Coles County as of July 28, 2021, is **Six-Thousand, and Thirty-Three. Five-Thousand, Eight-Hundred and Seventy-Four** recovered, **One-Hundred and One** deceased, and **Fifty-Eight** recovering.

### Case Data:

July 24, 2021: **6** new cases  
July 25, 2021: **3** new cases  
July 26, 2021: **9** new cases  
July 27, 2021: **10** new cases  
July 28, 2021: **11** new cases
