Subject: **Coles County Health Department COVID-19 Case Count Updates**

Coles County Health Department, (CCHD) is reporting additional laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases. Our total confirmed COVID-19 laboratory case count for Coles County as of June 16, 2021, is **Five-Thousand, Nine-Hundred and Fifteen** with **Two** currently hospitalized, **Five-Thousand, Eight-Hundred and Two** recovered **Ninety-Nine** deceased, and **Twelve** recovering.

Case Data for June 16, 2021: **3** new cases

CCHD and The Illinois National Guard (ILNG) Mobile Outreach Vaccination Point of Dispensing (POD) will be offering **Pfizer** COVID-19 vaccinations to 12 years of age and older. The clinics are open to anyone who lives in Illinois and meets the age requirement.
