Coles County Health Department, (CCHD) is reporting additional laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases. Our total confirmed COVID-19 laboratory case count for Coles County as of June 21, 2021, is **Five-Thousand, Nine-Hundred and Twenty-One** with **One** currently hospitalized, **Five-Thousand, Eight-Hundred and Four** recovered **Ninety-Nine** deceased, and **Seventeen** recovering.
